3. FUNDRAISING

Kilmer swag – Ordered winter hats, stickers and reusable shopping bags – will be ready for pick up the week of 1/14/19. Will start promotion of items for purchase at Parent Night Out. Thanks to parent, Tina Ryan for coordinating the order. Discussion of other items being available for purchase directly through SuperFlash via individual order forms (items like sweatshirts, sweatpants, t-shirts, etc). Need to gather more info on how this will work best.

KidStuff coupon books – new fundraiser - coupon books filled with coupons for local businesses and services. \$25 each, school receives 50% of all sales.

Scholastic Book Fair – will run book fair **during the March Open House**. Idea to have fair at one location (Lower school) with books for Kindergarten through 8th grade readers, and also offer online fair. When fair is run at both Lower and Upper, Scholastic has higher sales requirements to reach maximum fundraising potential. Two parents volunteered to be the point people for the fair.

Bertucci’s/West/Paint Night – in the process of being finalized. Dates TBD. Would still like to add more restaurants in Roslindale. Napper Tandy’s and Yogurt place mentioned as potential businesses to reach out to.
