## 1. Welcome/Introductions

## 2. Budget Overview

- Maybe send a reminder next year that Upper school students need to be accompanied by an adult.

## 4. Upcoming Fundraising

*Yankee Candle fundraiser* – ends on 10/12

*Box Top* – Box Tops due Monday 10/29 for 11/2 submission deadline. We will take any Box Tops, but it would be a big help if parents could check expiration dates and clip them neatly before sending them in.

*Election Day Bake Sale* – Need parents to donate baked goods (homemade or store bought) and coffee for the bake sale. Baked goods need to be dropped off to the main offices of the Upper and Lower school the day before (11/5). Also need parents to volunteer to work shifts. Signup Genius will go out for signups.

## 5. Future Fundraising

Upcoming fundraisers - Winter Paint Night, Scholastic Book Fair, Spring Parent Event, 2 Bertucci's nights, Celtics/Red Sox Nights

- Discussion of having a donation book sale where parents would donate books, rather than holding a Scholastic fair. Scholastic fair is an equal amount of work, and JKS has to share the majority of the sales with Scholastic.
- Celtics group ticket sales is run a little different this year where there is a lottery system. Christine has already put our name in, but not guaranteed, as it was last year.

- Spring Parent Event – ideas to change it up a bit from last year. A smaller venue would be great. Very tough to find a venue for 2018 event. Idea to move to a week night, rather than a Friday or Saturday. Opens up more options. Brainstormed location ideas.

## 6. Kilmer Community Events
